Bulk Waste consists of any large or heavy items that cannot fit into a garbage cart, yard waste container, or will make a garbage/yard waste container weigh more than 50 lbs. The three (3) types of bulk waste are: household goods/personal property, construction & demolition debris (C&D), and yard waste. Bulk waste types must be separated by type and **scheduled ahead of placing on the right of way (ROW)** with Waste Management (WM) to have the debris removed. Call 305-296-8297 to schedule a pickup.

Each **residential** property is allotted two (2) bulk pick-ups of 2 cubic yards (CY) or less (a pile that is 3 feet x 3 feet x 6 feet in dimension) of **household/personal items**. Such pick-ups require scheduling by the property owner/resident with WM. Piles that exceed 2 CYs or the annual frequency limit require prepayment for removal. **C&D and bulk yard waste are not included in this service.**

ALL residents, including those that live on Lanes, must call WM at 305-296-8297 to schedule a bulk pick up **BEFORE** placing items on the ROW otherwise it is illegal dumping. Only place the items on the ROW the day before the scheduled pick up to deter scavenging or others from adding to the pile. **DONATE ITEMS THAT ARE STILL USABLE, DO NOT PLACE THEM ON THE ROW AS "FREE".**

A truck with a claw arm is used to remove items so be sure to have items piled so they are not leaning on trees, fences, buildings, etc., obstructed by vehicles, or have overhead utility lines or tree branches which will interfere with collection.

Common Household/Personal Items - are sofas/couches, tables, chairs, shelving, end tables, nightstands, mattresses, box springs, patio furniture, area rugs, large appliances used in a home: washing machines, dryers, stoves/ovens, refrigerators, freezers, water heaters, grills (with propane tank removed), bicycles, window air conditioners, box fans, pedestal fans, ceiling fans, lamps, kid's toys. **If it fits in your garbage cart put it in the cart for removal.**

C&D Debris - is any item generated from construction, demolition, or remodeling/renovation projects: pallets, concrete block, concrete pieces, driveway/walkway pavers, steppingstones, rocks, soil, roofing shingles, roofing metal, building lumber, plywood, wall board, dismantled plastic, metal or wooden sheds, fencing, deck lumber, large wood/concrete/ceramic planters, toilets, kitchen cabinets, bathroom cabinets, countertops, PVC and metal piping etc. C&D is **NOT ALLOWED** in green garbage carts.

Yard Waste – is large yard debris that cannot be containerized or exceeds the allowed 400-gallon collection for each service week. Vegetation in plastic bags will not be collected. This method of containerization does not allow the material to be recycled or composted.

Bulk waste may be self-hauled by City residents to the City of Key West transfer station and will be charged the current transfer station tipping fee rate.

Commercial businesses are required to arrange and pay for all bulk waste removal and will be invoiced for a separate service on the monthly invoice with WM.
