Residential solid waste services are paid annually on tax bills through a non-ad valorem assessment. Weekly services are provided curbside on the same day each week, for 52 weeks a year. Services include:

- One (1) 96-gallon green cart for storage of household garbage - waste must be bagged before being placed in the cart. **Non-containerized items will not be collected.**
- One (1) 64-gallon cart for the storage of single-stream recyclables – waste must NOT be bagged.
- Collection of up to 400 gallons of yard waste in **RESIDENT-PROVIDED** containers or paper bags. **Plastic bags are NOT an acceptable means of containerization**
- Two (2) annual bulk pickups per household. Items/piles must not exceed two (2) cubic yards or be less than (a pile of 3' x 3' x 6'). Call WM at 305-296-8297 to schedule.

Green garbage and blue recycling carts **will not** be serviced if they are overflowing, overweight, and unsafe to mechanically lift, contain yard waste, construction & demolition debris, tires, or any other prohibited wastes.

Additional bulk pickups (outside of the two included pickups) will be collected curbside when scheduled with the franchise hauler and prepaid. Call WM at 305-296-8297 prior to placement on the right of way to schedule and arrange payment.

To purchase additional yearly garbage and recycling services, contact the City Solid Waste Coordinator for more information.

Label all containers/carts with the residence address (house number/unit).

The following wastes are accepted at the City Transfer Station and will be charged at the current transfer station tipping fee:

Municipal Solid Waste (MSW)	Yard Waste
Single stream recyclables	, Household hazardous waste, and E-waste
Bulk metal and appliances	Waste Tires
Construction & Demolition debris (C&D) – limited to 2 yards or less	
Mixed loads ARE NOT accepted	

Monthly Household Hazardous Waste and Electronic Waste drop-off occurs on the 1st Saturday of each month at Indigenous Park, 1800 White Street, from 8 AM-12pm.
